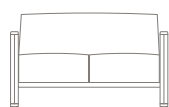

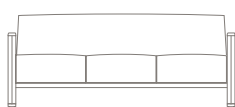

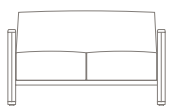
Lounge loveseat

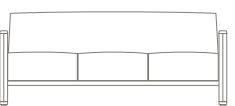
