

## Planter liner insert: Planting and watering instructions

---

## Liner overview

### General

- Planter liners have a self irrigation system with a bottom water reservoir that slowly disperse water to the plant

### Square planter liner

- For use with Hydra, Gathr Hydra, and Kaleid planters
- 7.3" w x 7.3" d
- Planting depth: 7" d
- Planting height: Max 20" h
- Planter volume: 1.3 US.dry.gal
- Water reservoir: 68 US.fl.oz

### Round planter liner

- For use with Fleet, Gathr Island and Gathr Obeya corner planters
- 8.3" dia.
- Planting depth: 5" d
- Planting height: Max 20" h
- Planter volume: 1.1 US.dry.gal
- Water reservoir: 27 US.fl.oz

## Plant care

### Plant placement

- Plants should be situated in a bright location that suits the needs of the respective plant
- **Note:** Some plants grow more favorably in semi-shaded areas, and not direct sunlight

### Fertilizing plants

- In the summer months, and after the plant's "growing-in phase", add commercial liquid fertilizer to the water every third watering according the individual package instructions

## Watering

### General

- Add water directly to the soil, until the water level indicator reads "max"
- The watering intervals depend on the planter size and location, as well as the plant's water needs
- If plant requires no special instructions, watering is only required about every 12 weeks

### Delayed watering

- The following applies in general: The warmer and lighter the location of the plant, the shorter the watering intervals
- When the water level indicator reads "min" after a few days to several weeks, do not water immediately. This is the start of the "dry phase" for the plant - depending on the size of the planter, its location and the plant itself, this phase can last for approximately two to ten days.
- Begin watering the plant again regularly after this brief "water-free" phase
